The Academy of Sciences and Literature in Mainz invites applications for

a six-month internship for students or young scientists with Ukrainian citizenship.

The Academy of Sciences and Literature is dismayed by the Russian invasion of Ukraine. At the same time, it sees it as an attack on elementary values of freedom, democracy and self-determination. Our thoughts are with the people of Ukraine, to whom we extend our full solidarity. We are determined to continue our scientific and artistic contacts with our colleagues in Ukraine.

As a short-term measure, the Academy offers students or young scholars who have to leave their country as a result of the Russian aggression the opportunity for further qualification within the framework of a 6-month internship in the field of Digital Humanities. **The internship will be rewarded with an appropriate remuneration as a living allowance.**

The call for applications is aimed at Ukrainian students or young academics with an interest in scientific issues of the Digital Humanities which are addressed by the Digital Academy in projects of the Academies Programme of the Union of the German Academies of Sciences and Humanities.

With the Digital Academy, the Mainz Academy has established a recognized research department for Digital Humanities since 2009 in which not only digitization, but in particular digital research methods and technologies based on it are bundled.

The research and activity field of the Digital Academy ranges from conceptual consulting for new applications and ongoing projects over the monitoring of academy projects in the context of evaluations to the acquisition and implementation of its own research projects.

Personal Qualification:

- Language skills (German and/or English)
- Independent and team-oriented handling of issues related to the Digital Academy
- Experience in the development of research software and programming interfaces (APIs) with XML-technologies (XML, XPath, XQuery and XSLT)
- Experience in front-end development (HTML5, CSS3, JavaScript).

Application documents:

- Letter of motivation explaining your interest in the internship (1 page).
- Curriculum vitae in table form with details of studies and language skills
- photocopy of the university degree certificate with individual grades of the subjects studied
